### PRIOR TO THE WORKSHOP DAY:

#### Space:

- Gym, cafeteria, multi-purpose room or auditorium.
- 10-foot ceilings MINIMUM.
- Flooring: wood, marley, linoleum. Carpet is okay, but not recommended. NO CEMENT.
- Classroom with chairs pushed back NOT ACCEPTABLE.

#### Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

#### Attire:

- Students can leave shoes on if they are athletic shoes, otherwise they should go barefoot. Students should be dressed comfortably, able to roll or sit on the floor – no skirts or dresses. Students and teachers must remove obtrusive jewelry/belts, for example, large rings, long dangling earrings, etc. No gum.

#### Assistance:

- One teacher per thirty-five students.

#### Equipment:

- DVD and Monitor (first workshop day)
- CD Player or boombox
- Drinking water

### ON WORKSHOP DAY:

#### Arrival:

- 30-45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.

#### Parking:

- Two spaces.

#### Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the artist and to stay and help as needed.

#### Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the workshop space, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
